**INNER COURTYARD  
EINSTEINSTRASSE**

The run-down and completely asphalted yard of a former car plumbing company was turned into a Japanese garden in the course of reconstructing the edifice. In the dry landscape garden (Kare Sansui) bright gravel symbolizes water, which springs as a stream from an abstract cascade forming the idealistic core of the facility and outgoring into the sea. Granite rocks act as bridges between residential area and office. A wooden terrace and a sand pit bring complete the site. The plantings consist of maple, boxtrees, yews and azalea.
